## Executive Director's Message – 2024 Utah Operation Lifesaver Annual Summary

Another year has passed, and Utah Operation Lifesaver has summarized the data for 2024. While statistics do not tell the entire story, data provides valuable information for us to evaluate what happened in 2024. One of the four "Es" for Utah Operation Lifesaver and National Rail Safety Alliance is "Evaluation." Rail safety in Utah for 2024 was about the same as last year. Table 1 shows the highway-rail grade crossing and trespass incidents for both the United States and Utah. In addition to freight and tourist rail, the statistics below include UTA TRAX light-rail and FrontRunner commuter rail numbers for Utah.

## Mike Murphy steps down as President of the Hostlers Model Railroad Club

After 36 years as president of the Hostlers Model Railroad Club, Mike Murphy has decided to step down as president but continue as treasure. Mike has written more than 400 president's messages in the Hostler News newsletter. Hostlers started in the spring 1988 with early members Dick Watson, Maynard Morris, Mike Murphy, and Brian Ripley all started meeting together. By September, the club had 20 members and met at each other's homes on a rotating basis. Under Mike's leadership, the club expanded in membership, created model railroad modules, held social events, created an annual model railroad festival, developed a model railroad museum at Newgate Mall, and inspired generations of model railroad enthusiasts.
